## Sunshine House

Sunshine House offers short breaks for children and young people with long term conditions, life limiting conditions and/or complex health needs.

We also offer end of life care if this is the child, young person and/or their family's choice.

Our 24 hour service provides holistic care to children and young people aged 0-18 from Hull and East Riding.

### Sunshine House offers:

- A home from home environment that supports children and young people's individual needs and encourages friendship, play and fun activities.
- Short breaks including overnight, weekend and day care.
- Monthly weekend youth club where young people can be with their friends, enjoy planned activities, themed events and local trips out.

### The Team

We are a team of Children's, Adult and Learning Disability Nurses, Health and Development Practitioners and Health Care Support Workers.

## Facilities

All rooms at Sunshine House are fully equipped to meet the needs of the children and young people we care for. Each room has been designed to provide a relaxed and calm atmosphere.



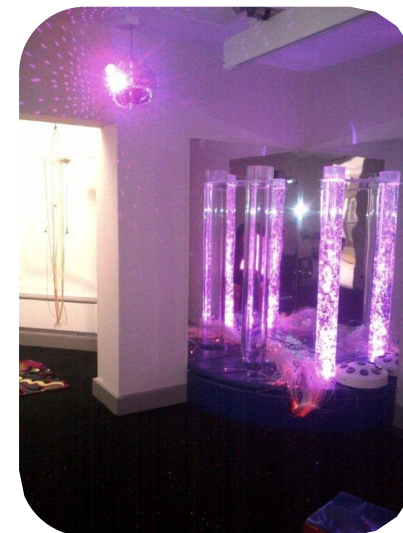
## Forget-Me-Not Room

The Forget-Me-Not room is a purpose built room for children and young people to spend time when they have reached the end of their lives. This room has a unique atmosphere that allows families to stay in an adjoining room with their children for as long as they need, to say their goodbyes in their own time.



## Sensory Room

Our purpose-built sensory room is a multi-functional room. It can provide a relaxing and calming atmosphere, as well as a stimulating and interactive space for children and young people to enjoy.



## Support for parents, families and carers

We support and teach parents and carers how to use specialist equipment and offer competency based, child and young person specific training and support.

We assess children and young people with complex care needs for continuing care funding and work in partnership with other agencies to facilitate a smooth and planned transition into adult services.
